In-party voting systems In-party voting systems divide MPs into different party groups based on the party they belong to. All MPs are listed in the order of their party group and are then ranked, usually based on the size of their party group. If the number of MPs is lower than the number of seats available for the number of parties in the legislature, then the list may be split into two or more lists, each with a number of MPs equal to the number of available seats, and the MPs are then ranked within each list based on the order of their party group. The MP lists are combined to create a party group list, and that list is then ranked by size. If the legislative agenda is being considered by two or more parties, all lists are then combined to create the party group list and that list is then ranked based on the number of MPs in the combined list. A multi-seat party (i.e., those with more than one MP) may also elect to have voting allocated between party groups, usually based on a simple majority rule. In this scenario, if a party has both a majority of MP seats in one party group and a majority in another, MPs from both groups are ranked based on their order in one list, and then the MPs in the other party group are added to the list. If this is the case, then in the combined party group list, the party with a majority of seats in one party group always wins one place, and the party with a majority in the other party group will win another place. If the party with a majority of seats wins at least half of the places in the party group list, it will gain a majority in the legislature and become the government. If it loses, then the least successful party group will become the opposition. The majority of voting systems for Parliament are variations of in-party systems, although proportional representation voting and the most common form of multi-party systems also exist. Hammered systems A hammered system is a variation of the first-past-the-post system which uses counting methods to achieve a near proportional result. A commission is appointed to make recommendations on voting reform, and after considering a number of options they choose one to recommend to the national parliament.
